The 7 Emotional Marketing Angles:

1) Value based angle: Emphasizes the value that a product or service provides to customers. Appeals to customers' desire for quality, convenience, or expertise.

Example: "How to GET RID of stubborn belly fat"

Example 2: "3 tips to reduce excess fat effectively"

2) Curiosity based angle: Piques customers' curiosity by asking questions, making bold statements, or creating intrigue. Encourages customers to click to learn more.

Example 1: According to Experts, here are 3 tips to visibly reduce excess fat without exercising in 2025

Example 2: This new breakthrough from scientist is turning hair loss industry!

3) Testimonial based angle: Uses social proof, such as customer testimonials or reviews, to build trust and credibility. Appeals to customers' desire for validation and reassurance.

Example 1: "See how my Full Facebook Advertising Course helped Oluamara Success increase her sales by 57%." **fsguniversity.com.ng/updated/** (click on this link or copy to your browser to grab this offer)

Example 2: "The sharp pain in my feet is gone ... I truly feel like it's a prayer answered!"

4) Fear based angle: This Uses fear or anxiety to motivate customers to take action. Appeals to customers' desire to avoid loss or negative consequences.

Example: "Imagine looking back on this moment and wondering what could have been.... Don't let regrets hold you back!

Example 2: "5 Early Warning Signs You May Be At Risk For a Heart Attack Or Stroke In The Next 3 Months"

5) Offer based angle: Emphasizes special offers, discounts, or promotions to create a sense of urgency and encourage customers to take action. Appeals to customers' desire for value and savings.

Example 1: "Limited time offer: Get 50% off my Full Facebook advertising course." *fsguniversity.com.ng/updated/ (click on this link or copy to your browser to grab this offer)

Example 2: Get 18 of my best tools, templates, campaigns, and courses for 99.63% off!

6) Results Based Angle: Focuses on the specific results that customers can achieve by using a product or service. Appeals to customers' desire for tangible outcomes and success.

Example 1: A full night of sleep is a GAME CHANGER!

Example 2: "Increase your Facebook ad conversions by 30% with our proven strategies."

7) Benefits-based angle: Emphasizes the benefits that customers can experience by using a product or service, such as increased productivity, improved well-being, or enhanced enjoyment. Appeals to customers' desire for positive outcomes and experiences.

Example: "How You Too Can Work Less Hours, Make More Money & Finally Live Life On Your OWN Terms—Almost Immediately!"
